To the Board of Directors of Anubhav Infrastructure Limited

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Un-audited Financial Result ('Statement') of Anubhav Infrastructure Limited ('the Company') for the third quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2020, which are included in the accompanying "Statement of Unaudited Financial Results for the third quarter and nine months December 31, 2020" together with the notes thereon (the "Statement").
